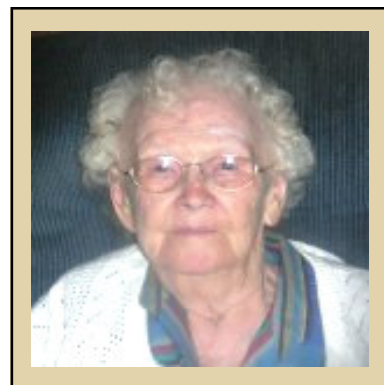


## THE LOVE OF A MOTHER

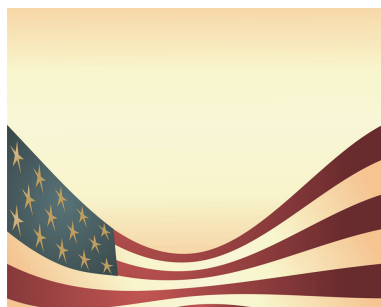

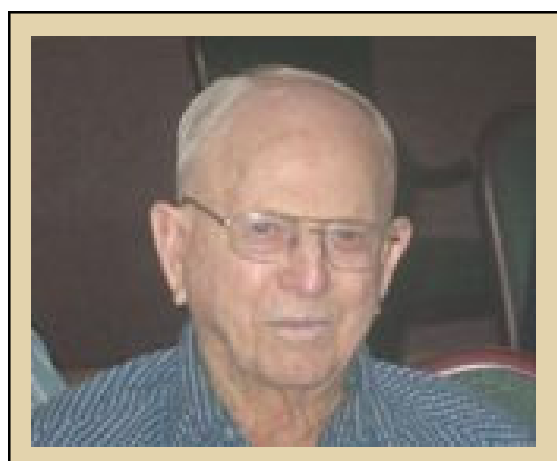


## MEMORIAL DAY
