This was very interesting to hear how the store got started

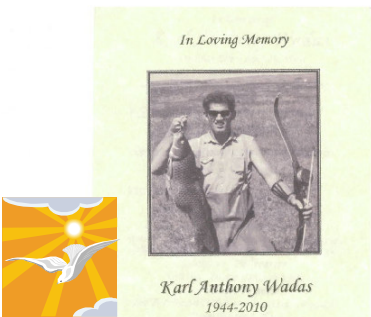
